

## **THE MEADOWS NEIGHBORHOOD COMPANY COMMUNITY AMENITIES KEY FACTS**

The Meadows invites play and adventure everywhere you look. With so many Castle Rock parks, trails and amenities in your own backyard, you will want to be outside in the warm Colorado sunshine year-round. Over 1,100 acres is dedicated for public use, trails and open spaces. So come out and play. Walk the dog. Play tennis at Bison Park. Train for the Bolder Boulder. Don't forget to check out Music in The Meadows and the Castle Rock WineFest this summer. The Grange Cultural Arts Center and The Taft House are home to dozens of activities. You're sure to find the one that is just right for you!

### **THE GRANGE CULTURAL ARTS CENTER**

Designed to reflect the community's ranching heritage, The Grange at Castle Rock is the heart of The Meadows. The spacious interior of the main building can be used for activities such as art exhibits, performing arts, classes and events. It can also be rented out for meetings, parties, weddings and private events. There are numerous clubs to join including, mahjong, a bridge club, a hiking club and more. The Grange at Castle Rock is also a place for the family, with a children's story hour and plenty of fun summer days at the pool. Outdoors is a four-lane, 25-yard recreational pool, a six-lane lap pool and shallow lesson pool, along with a family-oriented, zero-entry play pool, a water slide and two bath houses that include changing rooms and a snack and beverage area. The pools are open Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. ### **THE TAFT HOUSE**

The Taft House is conveniently located between Elegant and Low Meadow just off of Meadows Blvd. It is also the administrative office for The Meadows Neighborhood Company (HOA). The bright red umbrellas mark the location of this fun center. The Taft House has a multipurpose room available for rent, and it hosts events and various classes as well. Other features include a sand volleyball court and a unique pool facility. The Taft House pool features a bubble pit, play structure, climbing wall and vortex pool.

### **NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS**

Many neighborhoods in The Meadows include neighborhood parks with benches, playscapes, picnic shelters and pristine lawns. The Stewart Park neighborhood park even has built-in cornhole boards! This neighborhood park is located at the corner of North Meadows Blvd and UMBER Circle.

## **WIGGLY FIELD (DOG PARK)**

Dogs need a lot of exercise and what better way to let them roam free and find playmates than at the Wiggly Field in The Meadows. Wiggly Field is an off-leash dog park, just north of Paintbrush Park on Meadows Boulevard, providing a clean, controlled environment for walking, exercising and playing with dogs.

## **NATIVE LEGEND OPEN SPACE**

Both a pedestrian freeway and a quiet network of trails that connect you to the outdoors, Native Legend Open Space and Trail runs through the heart of The Meadows. Some parts bustle with joggers, dog walkers, and kids zipping to school. It is a practical way to get around on foot, bike, or in-line skates. Other parts invite a Sunday afternoon stroll, plenty of room for a quiet hike, star gazing and practicing the names of your favorite Rocky Mountain peaks. The mountains and foothills are beautiful from Native Legend Open Space, but they also tell a story. One that's brought to life through Interpretive Learning Stations created in collaboration with the Denver Museum of Nature & Science. Through five stone monuments placed along the walking trails in the Native Legend Open Space, you can learn about the area's pre-historic plant life, geological history, fossils, and even what dinosaurs may have roamed The Meadows.

## **RIDGELINE OPEN SPACE**

The newest and largest open space and trail system in The Meadows, Ridgeline Open Space is made up approximately 370 acres and over 7 miles of trails. What makes Ridgeline Open Space unique, other than its size, is that the trails are native surface which are inviting to mountain bike enthusiasts and novices alike. The soft-surface trails travel through valleys and across ridgeline where visitors can take in the view of the Front Range to the west and the Town of Castle Rock to the east as they traverse through open grassland and dense Gambel Oak. Parking for Ridgeline Open Space is available at Bison Park, adjacent to Clear View Elementary School in the Morningview Neighborhood.

## **BUTTERFIELD CROSSING PARK**

At 28-acres, this is the big park. Here you'll find a playground and a 25-meter swimming pool. Butterfield Crossing Park is also home to several fields and courts – you'll come here to play soccer, tennis, basketball and baseball. In the summer, bring a lawn chair and invite a neighbor for Music in The Meadows, our popular series of outdoor concerts.

## **PAINTBRUSH PARK**

Centrally located next to The Grange, Paintbrush Park offers two baseball fields, a soccer field, a horseshoe pit, playground equipment, a picnic shelter, and a climbing wall. A footbridge connects the

park to Native Legend Open Space, which will lead you to the East Plum Creek Trail where the possibilities are endless. Paintbrush Park also sits adjacent to Wiggly Field, The Meadows' off-leash dog park.

### **BISON PARK**

Sitting adjacent to Clear Sky Elementary School in the Morningview Neighborhood, Bison Park features two synthetic turf fields, resulting in a savings of 2.5 million gallons of water per year. The park also features four tennis courts. Bison Park also has a climbing area with a life sized bison play structure, a sand play area, and other unique play equipment as well as wheelchair-accessible elements throughout, including accessible swings.

### **PHILIP S. MILLER PARK**

The 320 acre park is located in the southern portion of The Meadows with a variety of unique features including a fieldhouse, indoor leisure/lap pool, zip line course, Epic Adventure Tower, Epic Sky Trek, adventure playground, trails with 200-step incline, FitGround outdoor adult fitness park, amphitheater and an outdoor lighted athletic field. ### **DEPUTY ZACK S. PARRISH III MEMORIAL PARK**

This 5.5-acre park, located at 2020 Fiddle Road, honors the public safety profession and the men and women who work to keep the community safe. Opened and dedicated in August 2019, the park features two play structures, picnic pavilions, a multi-use field, pickle ball and bocce ball courts, cornhole boards and horseshoe pits. Additionally, a memorial has been built at the park to honor Deputy Parrish, and public safety personnel.

### **MERCANTILE SQUARE**

Coming 2021. This park will be located in the heart of The Meadows Town Center. It will feature an amphitheater, firepits, and areas for entertaining.
