

## The Meadows Pools FAQs Summer 2020

### How do I get a pool FOB?

Already have a key fob? If you are a Meadows Neighborhood Company (MNC) homeowner, and already have a key fob, you do not have to do anything; your key fob will automatically be activated for this 2020 season. Typically we ask children under 18 to update their picture each year, however, due to COVID, we are not updating pictures for the 2020 season.

If you are:

- A new MNC homeowner
- Adding a new member to your household
- A resident that has not received a key fob in the past
- Renting a home in the MNC

### Who needs a waiver?

- a) COVID-19 release waivers **will be required** for all residents and caregivers entering the pool facilities. The Association will deny entry to any person who does not have a signed waiver on file.
- b) Waivers will be available online and must be submitted 72 hours prior to first time using the pool for the 2020 season. Waivers not submitted 72 hours in advance, can fill out a waiver in person at the pool entry. Waivers can be sent to [pools@meadowslink.com](mailto:pools@meadowslink.com)
  - 1) Waivers will only need to be filled out once for the summer.

- c) Persons age 18 and over must submit their own waiver. Persons under age 18 must have their legal guardian sign the waiver.
- d) Failure to complete and submit a waiver will result in loss of pool usage.

### Can I bring guests?

Guest passes will be disabled based on the capacity limitation. This may be revised later in the summer depending on COVID updates.

### Can my caregiver come?

Yes, you may register your caregiver in your reservation in your household.

If the caregiver is a minor (under age 18) they must submit a waiver filled out by **their** legal guardian. The caregiver may not sign the waiver for persons in their care unless they are the legal guardian.

Caregiver must be a “responsible and reliable person” and may only come to the pool when accompanying persons listed in the Member’s household who require care and who are ages 0-10, or others with demonstrated need. A person is a “responsible and reliable person” if he or she is 16 years of age or older and assumes full and complete responsibility for the safety of persons

who require supervision and are under his or her responsibility. A “responsible and reliable person” must accompany and remain with persons who require supervision at all times. Caregiver may not be a primary resident or a parent or guardian. Caregiver may not come to the pool alone, with children from other households, or with other adults.

**Do I need to wear a mask?**

Wearing of masks is highly recommended at all times when not in the water.

**Can MCA Residents buy a pool pass?**

Unfortunately due to the limit of 50 people, we will not be allowing MCA residents to purchase a pass. This may be revised later this summer based on capacity limits.

**Will there be lap swim?**

For the current time, there will not be lap swim hours in the morning. This may be revised later in the summer.

**Do we need to bring own chairs?**

No, we will have the pool furniture out and it will be sanitized in between each time slot.

**Can we still bring our own food and drinks?**

Food and drinks will be allowed in designated areas only. Personal food may be brought in to the pool facilities but cannot be within 5 ft. of the pools. Glass bottles and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming pool areas. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages on MNC property is strictly prohibited, and is cause for removal, except during MNC approved functions.

**Will the concession stands be open?**

The Grange and Taft House concession stands will not be open this year. Vending machines will be available for cash, apple pay and card payments.

**Can I host a birthday party at the Taft House?**

For the 2020 season, we are not taking birthday party reservations.
